

INSYLO COOKIES POLICY

By accessing and using our website at www.insylo.com you can decide which cookies you want us to apply.

Our website uses cookies to manage the well-functioning of the website, and to understand how it is being used so we can improve it and our services to you.

This document describes what information those cookies gather, how we use them, and why we make use of them. We also explain how you can restrict or block the cookies from being downloaded automatically. However, this might downgrade or even hinder certain elements of the website's functionality.

WHAT IS A COOKIE?

A cookie is a small text file which is stored on your computer or other device such as mobile phones or tablet devices by a website. Cookies allow a website to remember your preferences whilst visiting the site in order to provide you with a more personalised experience. They help to make websites work efficiently and can allow site owners to track how a site is used to provide useful data for making improvements.

HOW DOES INSYLO WEBSITE USE COOKIES?

Our website uses cookies to provide enhanced functionality and to gather information about how the site is being used to help us continually improve the user experience.

Unless you have adjusted your browser settings to refuse cookies, our website will issue cookies as soon as you visit. If you have switched off cookies, then some of the functionality of our site may not be available to you.

The cookies that we use only collect anonymous information to optimise our services, and do not collect personal information.

COOKIES ON OUR WEBSITE

In our website we use the following cookies:

Own cookies:

- Our website is based on the WORDPRESS technology, which uses the following cookies:
 - *_icl_current_language*: expires in one day
 - *wp-setting-3*: expires in forty-five days
 - *wp-setting-time-3*: expires in forty-five days
 - *wpml_referer_url*: expires in one day

These cookies are technical cookies, and they help us adapt our website to the user's browser.

Third party cookies:

- **VIMEO:** VIMEO cookies allow users to watch the video on our webpage. VIMEO provide the following cookies:

- *__gads*: expires in sixteen months
- *__ssid*: expires in ten years
- *__utma*: expires in nine months
- *_ga*: expires in sixteen months
- *has_logged_in*: expires in seven years
- *has_uploaded*: expires in seven years
- *optimizelyBuckets*: expires in seven years
- *optimezelyEndUserId*: expires in seven years
- *optimezelySegments*: expires in seven years
- *player*: expires in five months
- *site_setting*: expires in fifty-two years
- *stats_end_date*: expires in seven years
- *stats_start_date*: expires in seven years
- *void*: expires in two years
